STAR Reading

The Standardized Test for Achievement in Reading (STAR) is a computerized assessment used to identify students who are reading below grade level so that appropriate supportive interventions may be implemented

STAR tests are an important aspect of the district's assessment plan. STAR tests are administered to students who are independent readers three times during each school year to determine students' instructional reading levels and to document progress over time. STAR reports provide teachers and parents with individualized data on the reading development of each student.
